



**Call for Tenure Track Faculty Research Position(s)

The Department of Criminology, Bar Ilan University invites relevant candidates to apply for a tenure track research position at the level of lecturer or senior lecturer. Priority will be given to candidates with a track record and future trajectory of research excellence, whose research interests explore novel and under-represented topics within the department's existing areas of expertise (including, but not limited to, artificial intelligence (AI) and human-machine interaction, technology and crime, technology and therapy, policing, penology, trauma, substance use, and clinical criminology). We are also interested in candidates whose research excellence is accompanied by clinical expertise and training.

The successful applicant will have:

- Degrees in criminology, psychology, sociology, education, social work or related fields
- Post-doctoral research, preferable from outside Israel.
- A proven record of excellence in research (e.g. publications in international peer-reviewed journals, grants, prizes)
- Teaching experience is an advantage
- Ability to integrate and work in a team

Candidates must be fluent in Hebrew at a level sufficient for teaching.
